Gunkholing with Gizmo; Bunker's Wharf | from Issue 94, May 2007

- 1 --- Bunker's Wharf (www.bunkerswharfrestaurant.com, 207-963-2244), under new management as of July, 2007.
- 2 --- Outer ledges, which only uncover at about half tide (leave them all to starboard, favoring the shore).
- 3 --- Beginning of Acadia National Park; Schoodic Drive is one-way counterclockwise within the park's borders.
- 4 --- East Trail to 440' high Schoodic Head, with some fine views of Mt. Desert.
- 5 --- Anvil Trail is gorgeous, if somewhat challenging.
- 6 --- New Schoodic Education and Research Center (see www.acadiapartners.org) took over the old Navy Base.
- 7 --- Schoodic Point overlook, famous ocean view.
